National Protect Your Hearing Month: October

12 million Americans have noise-induced hearing loss. Noise-induced hearing loss is caused by exposure to loud noise over 85 dB, such as concerts, sporting events, shooting, motorcycles, and more. If you have decreased or “muffled” hearing after exposure, that is a sign of temporary and possibly permanent hearing damage. Using power tools, lawnmowers, guns, and attending concerts requires the use of hearing protection to prevent noise-induced hearing loss. An environment is too loud and considered dangerous if you, 1. have to shout over background noise to be heard; 2. it is painful to your ears; 3. it makes your ears ring during and after exposure.



Ways to Protect Your Hearing

- Wear hearing protection when around loud sounds. Mile High Hearing provides custom made hearing protection options for many purposes such as concerts, motorcycles, shooting, and sleep.
- Turn down the volume when listening to the radio or MP3 player.
- Walk away from loud noise.
